How Often to Change Manual Transmission Fluid. The fluid of manual transmissions has a shorter lifespan. The typical manufacturer of a manual vehicle will tell you to change your fluid at around 30,000 to 60,000 miles. Of course, every make and model will likely have a different recommendation, but one that is within this range of miles.

How Often to Change Transmission Fluid (Manual and Automatic)

The manual transmission Toyota Corolla requires 75W-90 GL-4 transmission fluid. I use and recommend the Red Line MT-90. In order to fill the transmission fluid, we need to get a funnel that can enter in the fill port. I use a long transmission fluid funnel, and put a little extra piece of hose on the end to make the bend.

If your transmission is not leaking we recommended that it be checked at each oil change and topped off. Beware that vibration caused by "out of balance" drive shafts can damage rear seals in both the transmission and transfer case, causing fluid leaks and ultimate damage to bearings and other critical parts.

The manufacturers of most vehicles recommend that you change your manual transmission fluid at least every 30,000 miles or at the most 60,000 miles, depending on the make and model of the manual vehicle.
