The Seasons (Lithuanian: Metai) is the first Lithuanian poem written by Kristijonas Donelaitis around 1765-1775. It is in quantitative dactylic hexameters as often used for Latin and Ancient Greek poetry. It was published as " Das Jahr " in Königsberg, 1818 by Ludwig Rhesa, who also named the poem and selected the arrangement of the parts.
