Property Rights in Investment Securities and the Doctrine ...

A "securities entitlement" includes all rights and property interest of an entitlement holder in a financial asset while a "securities account" refers to an account to which a financial asset is credited in accordance with an agreement under which the person maintaining the account (the security intermediary) undertakes to treat the person for whom the account is maintained (the entitlement holder) as entitled to exercise the rights comprising the financial asset.

The following rules govern priority among conflicting security interests in the same investment property: (1) A security interest held by a secured party having control of investment property under Section 9-106 has priority over a security interest held by a secured party that does not have control of the investment property.

Property rights have been likened to a bundle of sticks where each stick represents a right or stream of benefits.
